

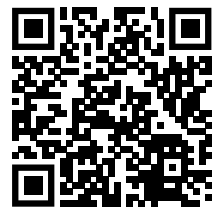
Know Your Numbers

How many loved ones will you **protect with safe drug disposal?**

Appropriate disposal of medications is important to keep you and your loved ones safe. Unused or expired prescription medications are a public safety issue, leading to accidental poisoning, overdose, and abuse. Dispose of medications no longer needed in a safe, convenient way.

Safe Disposal Saves Lives.

- Take the meds out of their bottles;
- Mix them with something unappealing like used kitty litter or coffee grounds;
- Seal them in a bag or disposable container, and throw that away.
- Do NOT:
 - Flush unused medications unless they are on the FDA Flush List
 - Dispose of unused medications in the trash without mixing with an unappealing substance first
 - Leave unused/expired medications in your home
